In an effort to balance these priorities, the Licking Township Board of Trustees have re-opened all buildings, will hold in-person meetings, and resume ALL services effective 4/15/2021 (*).

Licking Township Fire Company will adhere to the following additional safety measures for all visitors of the Fire Station:

- Masks must be worn at all times by ALL persons attending a meeting/hearing/visiting
- Sign-in for contact tracing purposes by ALL persons attending a meeting/hearing/visiting
- Temperature checks for all visitors
- Maintain 3'-6' social distancing
- If you have COVID symptoms or been in contact with someone who has COVID, please stay home
- Follow ALL established COVID-19 health and safety protocol

Licking Township Fire Company will adhere to the following safety measures for all Fire/EMS operations:

- Follow all COVID-19 health and safety protocol listed above
- Follow all PPE guidelines
- Increased cleaning and sanitization of high touch points at the Fire Station and Fire/EMS vehicles
- Closely monitor the health and well-being of all LTFC employees and follow all established health and safety protocols
- Provide & maintain touchless hand sanitizing stations inside entry doors of all buildings
- Provide & maintain clear markings/room lay-out to ensure social distancing
- Medic runs with respiratory complaints, before entering home/business will ask if patient is ambulatory. If so, ask the patient to meet at the door and place a mask on the patient before making any other contact if appropriate signs/symptoms are present or otherwise known.
