

Minutes of the Board of Licking Township Trustees, **Regular Meeting** held @ Licking Township Fire Company Station #600 @ 7:30 p.m., August 16, 2021.

Mr. Miller called the hearing to order at 7:30 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call: John Cormican, Dave Miller, and Andrea Lynch. John Holman was absent.

Others Present: Ed Monroe; Patrick McKinley; Gerald Layton; John Kreager; Doug Howell (*) Present but did not sign in.

The Board approved the meeting minutes as presented.

Mr. Miller made a motion to approve the bills totaling \$246,349.58

Mr. Cormican seconded the motion.

The Fiscal Officer presented information concerning the 3-year Provident Insurance & Accident Policy for LTFC. A discussion took place.
